### Meeting the Challenge!

We were optimistic that we might be able to return to a more typical school year in 2021-22. Unfortunately, COVID continued to disrupt school schedules and student routines. SSEF did what we have come to do best: we assessed and quickly pivoted to provide timely, needed virtual and in-person programs to benefit struggling students. (We definitely learned how to be incredibly flexible and responsive during the pandemic!)

SSEF expanded our successful virtual Tutor Teams program to include an additional elementary school. This program addresses student academic needs and fosters positive relationships between high school and elementary school students. The best part is that both tutors and their pupils loved working together and accomplished so much! We also continued our Summer Book Club. Over 85% of students who participated maintained or improved their reading levels. SSEF provided numerous mentoring opportunities via a combination of in-person and virtual formats; Link With a Leader, Reading Buddies, SAIL and Senior Push all moved forward, in spite of pandemic-related challenges. We administered our long-standing after-school programs that provide academic and enrichment activities for middle and high school students. In addition, via community donations, we provided school supplies for over 4,000 students and distributed more than 12,000 books.

Our annual STEAM Showcase was a highlight of the year. Over 2,500 students and community members enjoyed this in-person event featuring 35 interactive STEAM-focused exhibits provided by businesses and post-secondary institutions. As always, student beneficiaries of our STEAM grants exhibited their work. Everyone was pleased to see this event back live, generating a sense of normalcy.

As students recover from pandemic-related learning loss and social isolation, we aspire to continue to provide valuable supplemental programs in our public schools in Sandy Springs. We so value our community's on-going support in helping us offer resources to help all students succeed. Thank you for making a difference in their lives! Here's hoping that the 2022-2023 school year will bring us back to a "new normal"!






#### **INCOME**

#### **SSEF Tutor Teams Program**

We launched our pilot Tutor Teams program during the 2020-21 school year to support students who suffered pandemic-related academic setbacks. This weekly virtual program paired high schoolers and elementary students to help with homework, math and reading skills. SSEF initially recruited tutors from the International Baccalaureate and National Honor Society (NHS) programs at Riverwood International Charter High School. Once word spread, high schoolers from the Riverwood HS Community Service Club, Youth Leadership Sandy Springs and a Sandy Springs private school volunteered.

The results were amazing: 78% of our Ison Springs students in 1st through 5th grades maintained or increased their reading scores and 94% increased their math scores. The pilot program was so successful, we expanded in 2021-22 to include North Springs High School NHS students and 1st and 2nd graders at Dunwoody Springs Elementary. We were thrilled that 100% of the Dunwoody Springs students improved both their math and reading scores! This program turned out to be a real win-win for tutors and students.
